- * Will this story be a happy, sad, scary story?
- * What characters do you think might be in the book?
- * Do you think there will be problem in the story? Why?
- * Does the topic or story relate to you or your family? How?

DURING READING:

- * Where is the story taking place, the setting?
- * What has happened so far in the story?
- * What do you predict will happen next?
- * How do you think the story will end?
- * Why do you think the “character” did _____?
- * What would you have done if you were the “character”?
- * How would you have felt if you were the character?
- * How does this story make you feel, sad, happy, or scared? Why?
- * How do you think the story will end?

AFTER READING:

- * Was this a good title for the book/story? If you had to give it a different title, what would be another good title for it?
- * What was the problem of the story?
- * Why do you think the author wrote this?
- * What is the most important point that the author is trying to make in his/her writing?
- * What was your favorite part? Why?
- * If you could change one part, what would you change?
- * If you could ask the author a question, what would you ask?
- * Who was your favorite character in the story? How did it make you feel?
